- K: I just wanted to call you and tell you how saddened I am by the events that have caused you to return directly to Pakistan.
- B: I will be going straight back. You know, he was only 34 years old. He was just brilliant and very courageous. He was an outstanding man.
- K: Do you know who was behind the assassination.
- B: It was from across the frontier province -a Bhutan.
- K: Was there any political reason.
- B: Only that he was very good and effective and they send people from across the border and he is a victim of one of those bomb exercises.
- K: My deepest sympathy and the President asked me to extend his deepest sympathy to you and to tell you we think back to your visit here with great warmth.
- B: Please thank the President on my behalf for his concern.
- K: We will stay in touch.
- B: Whenever you like.
- K: My warm regards to Mrs. Bhutto.
- B: And mine to Nancy.
