BEGIN SUMMARY: THE INDIAN PRESS COVERAGE FEB. 11 OF PAKISTAN PRIME MINISTER BHUTTO'S ABC TELEVISION INTERVIEW WAS LIMITED TO BRIEF WIRE SERVICE ACCOUNTS WHICH APPEAR NON-PROMINENTLY IN MOST DELHI PAPERS. AIR/TV DID NOT BROADCAST THE INTERVIEW STORY. COMMENTS WERE BOTH CRITICAL AND BALANCED. END SUMMARY.

- 1. CREDITED TO THE PRESS TRUST OF INDIA, MOST PAPERS CARRIED BRIEF ITEMS ABOUT THE BHUTTO INTERVIEW ONLY THE COMMUNIST DAILY PATRIO AND THE STATESMAN GAVE THE STORY ANY SPECIAL PLAY ON FRONT PAGES. HEADLINES RELFECTED DIFFERENT VIEWPOINTS: "BHUTTO CITES 'VOLATILE REGION' FOR U.S. ARMS" (STATESMAN); "BHUTTO OPTIMISTIC GETTING ARMS" (INDIAN EXPRESS); "NO FINAL DECISION ON U.S. ARMS AID TO PINDI" (TIMES OF INDIA), AND "IF ARMS FOR IRAN, WHY NOT FOR PINDI?" (PATRIOT).
- 2. THE NEWS ACCOUNTS QUOTED THE PAKISTAN PRIME MINISTER WAS "HOPEFUL" THE U.S. WOULD LIFT ITS ARMS EMBARGO ALTHOUGH A "FINAL DECISION" HAD NOT BEEN TAKEN. SEEKING "PRIMARILY DEFENSIVE WEAPONS," MR. BHUTTO DEFENDED HIS REQUEST BY SAYING THAT PAKISTAN WAS IN A "VOLATILE REGION." THE ITEMS ALSO QUOTED THE PREMIER UNCLASSIFIED

SAYING THAT WHILE INDIA HAS BEEN RECEIVING "MASSIVE SOVIET ARMS," THE U.S. HAD CUT OFF ARMS SUPPLY TO PAKISTAN.

- 3. THE STATESMAN FIRST EDIT, "THE REAL TEST,"COMMENTED:
 "JUDGEMENT NEEDS TO BE SUSPENDED UNTIL IT IS KNOWN WHAT, IN FACT,
 WILL BE SUPPLIED" BECAUSE "THE TEST WILL BE IN THE NATURE AND
 VOLUME OF SUPPLIES." IT STRESSED THAT NEW DELHI "CANNOT DENY
 PAKISTAN THE RIGHT TO ARM ITSELF WITH EXTERNAL AID" BUT "CAN
 OBJECT TO AN INCREASE IN ISLAMABAD'S MILITARY STRENGTH THAT MIGHT

REFERRING TO THE REPORTED U.S. DECISION TO LIFT THE ARMS EMBARGO TO PAKISTAN, HE COMMENTED: "NEW DELHI SEEMS TO BE FOREVER PROTESTING ON THIS ISSUE...A BAN IS AT BEST AN ARTIFICIAL AND TEMPORARY EXPEDIENT..AND IT IS, MOREOVER, NOT SOMETHING ON WHICH INDO-US RELATIONS CAN BE BASED." HE CHARGED THAT NEW DELHI'S EXPRESSIONS OF DISAPPROVAL "HAVE THE HOLLOW RING OF BEING ONLY FOR THE RECORD" AND "WHAT IS BEING PLAYED IS DOMESTIC POLITICS." IN THE RESULT WASHINGTON HAS VIRTUALLY WRITTEN IT OFF IN FOREIGN POLICY TERMS... NEW DELHI'S EFFORTS TO CULTIVATE WEST ASIA HAVE YIELDED LITTLE... AND IT IS RIDICULOUS TO ASSUME THAT IT CAN MAKE ANY HEADWAY IN WEST ASIA UNTIL IT DEFINES ITS ATTITUDES TO THE UNITED STATES WITH CLARITY AND CONVICTION; AND THIS IT CAN DO ONLY BE MEANS OF FOREIGN POLICY AND NOT BY PLAYING POLITICS AT HOME."
- 6. ALL INDIA RADIO BROADCAST COMMENTS FROM "AN AUTHORITY ON MILITARY AFFAIRS" AND A "POLITICAL EXPERT." DISCUSSING THE MILITARY ASPECTS OF THE BHUTTO VISIT, LT. COL. GAUTAM SHARMA OBSERVED THAT"AMERICA IS INTERESTED IN STRENGTHENING PAKISTAN BY GIVING MORE UNCLASSIFIED

ARMS" SO THAT IT CAN "WATCH THE ACTIVITIES OF CHINA AND THE SOVIET UNION" FROM PAKISTAN. ALSO, "WHILE REMAINING IN THE PAKISTAN TERRITORY, AMERICA CAN PRESSURIZE US AND OUR POLICIES." DR. SATISH KUMAR POINTED OUT THAT "AMERICA WANTS TO CONTINUE ITS IN-
