Dear Ms. Lipton:

I refer to your FOIA request dated December 29, 2016, to the FBI for the release of certain material under the Freedom of Information Act (Title 5 USC Section 552). Of the relevant documents retrieved in response to your request, three were considered to be of primary interest to the Department of State, and were therefore referred to us for appropriate action.

After carefully reviewing these records, we have determined seven pages are appropriate for release in part, the excisions, requested by the FBI, are exempt from disclosure pursuant to:

- 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), which concerns material the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of an individual's personal privacy.
- 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C), which concerns records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes the release of which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of an individual's personal privacy.

8571. Appeals must be postmarked within 90 calendar days of the date of this initial agency decision letter. Please include a copy of this letter with your written appeal and clearly state why you disagree with the determinations set forth in this response.





- 3. EMBASSY WOULD APPRECIATE ANY FURTHER INFO DEPT CAN PROVIDE. CHARGE IS SCHEDULED FOR INFORMAL MEETING WITH PRES BHUTTO MARCH 28; PRESUME HE WOULD APPRECIATE ANYTHING WE CAN TELL HIM.
